IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

The European Aquatics Masters Championships 2026 introduce several important operational updates and new initiatives designed to enhance competition conditions, athlete experience, and accessibility.

SWIMMING PROGRAMME CHANGE - EARLIER START

Due to the centralisation of the Water Polo tournament at the x-bionic® sphere (Šamorín), the Swimming programme will start earlier than originally planned.

Official Swimming Schedule

Training Days:

16 August 2026
17 August 2026

Competition Days:

18 August – 24 August 2026

This adjustment ensures:

- Proper access to competition pools for Water Polo training
- Optimal preparation conditions for swimmers
- Efficient and safe venue operations
- Full compliance with European Aquatics event standards

All athletes and teams are requested to plan travel and arrival accordingly.

WATER POLO CENTRALISATION AT X-BIONIC® SPHERE

The entire Water Polo tournament will be held at the x-bionic® sphere in Šamorín.

- Training day 25 August 2026.
- Competition dates 26 – 30 August 2026.

Competition will take place across three official fields of play:

- Two fields in the Olympic 50 m outdoor pool
- One field in the 25 m indoor pool

This allows:

- Efficient scheduling of matches
- Reduced waiting times between games
- Optimal competition conditions

Additional training opportunities include:

- Dedicated Beach Water Polo training area
- Located directly at the open water canal
- Unique outdoor preparation environment

This integrated Water Polo setup creates complete Masters Water Polo environments.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Registration for the European Aquatics Masters Championships 2026 will be conducted exclusively through the official online registration system, accessible via the [Championships website](#).

All athletes and teams must complete their registration online within the published registration period. Detailed information regarding entry procedures, deadlines, accommodation booking, and catering options will be made available on the official website.

Participants are strongly encouraged to review all registration requirements carefully and complete the process within the specified deadlines.

LIABILITY DECLARATION – MANDATORY REQUIREMENT

As part of the registration process, all participants will be required to complete a Liability Declaration.

The Liability Declaration will be integrated into the online registration system and must be completed as part of the registration procedure.

Please follow the instructions at the website.

In addition, all participants are required to:

- Print the completed Liability Declaration form
- Sign the form with a physical signature
- Bring the signed original document to the Championships

The signed Liability Declaration must be presented during accreditation.

This document is mandatory for participation. Athletes who do not provide a signed Liability Declaration will not be permitted to compete.

ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENT

Accreditation will be provided upon successful completion of registration and submission of all required documents, including the signed Liability Declaration.

Accreditation is required for access to:

- Competition venues
- Training areas
- Athlete service areas
- Restricted operational zones

- Athletes with disabilities will compete in the same events as all other participants

This approach ensures equal participation conditions and reinforces the inclusive spirit of the Championships.

OBJECTIVES OF THE INCLUSION INITIATIVE

The integration of Para Aquatics disciplines within the Masters Championships aims to:

- Promote equal opportunity and accessibility in aquatic sport
- Provide meaningful competition opportunities for athletes with disabilities
- Strengthen the visibility and recognition of Para Aquatics within the Masters movement
- Encourage long-term athlete participation in aquatic sport
- Foster cooperation between aquatics organisations and federations

COMPETITION RULES AND PARTICIPATION

2026 Masters' Open Water Swimming Tour – Leg 1 and 2 – will be organized under the same rules as is stated in each provided bulletin.

2026 Masters' Open Water Swimming Tour – Leg 3 will be organised as part of the European Aquatics Masters Championships. The bulletin will be published separately, and the respective championship rules will apply.

To be included in the overall Tour ranking:

- Participation in all three stages is required
- Registration and payment procedures will be published separately for each event

The final stage of the European Aquatics Masters Open Water Swimming Tour will take place in the Danube backwater canal at the x-bionic® sphere in Šamorín, Slovakia.



The x-bionic® sphere aquatic complex provides Olympic-standard competition facilities.

OFFICIAL TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM

An official Championships transportation system will be provided to support athlete and team mobility during the event.

Transportation services will operate between:

- Official Championships accommodation locations, including x-bionic® sphere and partner hotels
- Competition venues in Šamorín and Bratislava
- Official Championships hotels and key operational locations

This system will ensure reliable and convenient transport for athletes, teams, and accredited participants, supporting smooth access to training sessions, competitions, and Championships services.

Detailed transportation schedules, routes, and operational information will be published on the official Championships website and in a future Information Bulletin.

INTERNATIONAL ACCESS

The Championships are easily accessible via major international airports:

- Vienna International Airport (Austria) – approximately 45 minutes from Šamorín
- Bratislava Airport (Slovakia) – approximately 30 minutes from Šamorín
- Graz Airport (Austria) – located within the host city

Vienna International Airport serves as the primary international gateway for participants traveling to the Championships.

ACCESSIBILITY

All competition venues, official hotels, and transportation services will support accessibility requirements and ensure equal access for all participants.

Barrier-free access, accessible accommodation, and appropriate athlete services will be available throughout the Championships.
