General Conditions

The Competition Rules (WB), the Legal Order and the Anti-Doping-Regulations of the German Swimming Federation apply. The competition is open to members of clubs or teams affiliated to a National Federation which is a member of FINA and is entitled to compete. All German participants must be registered and licensed.

Age Groups

Solo/Duet 20-29; 30-39; 40-49; 50-59; 60-69; 70-79; 80 and older

Trio/Team 20-34; 35-49; 50-64; 65-79; 80 and older

Combination 20-39; 40-65; 66 and older

Duet, Trio and Team might be swum crossing age groups. Scoring will be made according the general average age group.

Technical Routine

The FINA Competition Rules apply together with the Competition Rules (WB) of the German Swimming Federation for Technical Elements (Solo, Duet, Trio, Team) § 469 - § 471.

Time Limits for Technical Routines:

Solo up to 1 minute 30 seconds + 15 seconds

Duet/Trio up to 1 minute 40 seconds + 15 seconds

Team up to 1 minute 50 seconds + 15 seconds

Time Limits for Free Routines:

Solo up to 3 minutes + 15 seconds

Duet/Trio up to 3 minutes 30 seconds + 15 seconds

Team up to 4 minutes + 15 seconds

Combination up to 5 minutes + 15 seconds (including 10 seconds walk-on)

The combination will be scored according the Competition Rules (WB) § 432 - § 437

Entries

Entries can only be handed in by e-mail and only by using the new DSV-Form 400 (10-2012).

Entry lists

The entry list will be published on the website www.dmm2013.de in a printable version.

Fines (ENM)

For German participants only: A fine shall be imposed by the German Swimming Federation if a swimmer does not show at the session he has entered for.

Judges

The judges will be assigned by the referee.

For German participants/clubs only: All participant clubs must propose at least one judge with a valid license and hand in the proposal together with the entries. The club has to ensure that the named judges are available during the whole competition. It is obligatory to all judges to attend the judges' meeting.

According to WB AT § 10 (4) a fine of 150 € is imposed if a club does not present a judge or if the judge does not show.

An administrative fine of 35 € is imposed if a judge herself competes in the solo competition but serves as a judge in all other competitions. The same applies to clubs whose judge competes only in the duet competition. If any club's judges compete in the trio, team or combination and the club has not entered another licensed judge a fine of 75 € will be imposed.

Awards

Medals will be awarded to the first three placed. Certificates will be awarded exclusively for the Free Routines for the places 1 – 6 in all age groups.

Technical Data:

The competition facility applies to WB § 404 (1st and 2nd indent). A sound system for playing compact discs is available. The discs may only contain the music for one free routine. They have to be labeled with the name of the athlete, the name of the club and the competition details and must be handed to the sound engineer at least 30 minutes before the start of the competition.

Notes for Synchronized Diving:

- Mixed couples may compete
- Couples out of different clubs and countries may compete (the entry fee of 20 Euro will then be split in two)
- Couples out of the age groups >50 and <50 may compete. Scoring will be made according to the lower age group
- **Couples found on the location may compete! See paragraph 5 –Deadline**
