COMPETITION RULES

Taking into account the WA regulations for diving, participation takes place exclusively through the national associations. A maximum of 4 athletes per country can take part in the preliminaries for the individual competitions. A maximum of 2 athletes from each country can take part in the semifinal and final competitions. Two teams from Germany and one team from each of the host countries can take part in synchronized competitions. Only the best German team is included in the ranking. Synchronized competitions are only held as finals.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation cards will be issued upon teams' arrival. The list of accredited persons is based on the final entry forms.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

Arrival / Departure:

All participants will travel individually to Berlin or Rostock/ Laage, Germany. The organizing committee will provide transport from Berlin Airport and Rostock/Laage to Rostock will bear all cost. (one group per country) In case the arrival and departure times of team members will vary and additional transport is needed, the respective team will bear the extra cost. Please advise that judges should travel with their team, otherwise additional costs will occur on arrival and departure.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Individual events

The 66. International Divers Day will be included on the World Aquatics International Events Calendar, as well as the results being published.

Competition Format:

Dives

Men's individual events – 1m, 3m and 10m	6 dives without limit
Women's individual events – 1m, 3m and 10m	5 dives without limit

- **1m** competition consists only of preliminary and final. The 12 best participants will compete at the final.
- **3m and 10m** competitions consists of preliminary, semifinal and final. The 18 best divers will compete at the semifinal. The diving order will be the reverse of the preliminary ranking.
- The 12 best divers of the semifinals will compete at the final. The diving order will be the reverse of the semifinal ranking.

Synchronised diving events

There will be only Finals competition.

Men's synchro events - 3m and 10m	2 dives with limit DD 2,0 + 4 dives without limit

There is no limit on how many divers a National Federation can register but only the top 2 best scores can progress to the individual finals and only 1 synchronised team can be on the podium from the respective National Federation

World Aquatics Delegate

World Aquatics following the recommendation by the World Aquatics TDC, shall appoint a World Aquatics Delegate for this event. The World Aquatics Delegate shall conduct judging evaluations and shall present a written technical report and summary of evaluations to the World Aquatics TDC Commission and the TDC Judges' Sub- Committee Coordinator responsible for compilation of judging evaluations.

Judges

The Judging panel of Individual events shall be from different countries, if available. In addition, World Aquatics Certified Judges will be used for all events. If judges from seven different nations are not available, the judging panel will be reduced to five judges. In the Finals, the panel of judges shall consist of judges whose nationality is different to the of any of the participating divers, if available. In synchronized diving there shall be nine judges from different countries, if available. If not possible, there can be two judges from the same country, provided one is judging the execution and the other the synchronization.

If a National Federation team is greater than three athletes, then the National Federation must provide a judge. Each National Federation can provide up to maximum of 2 judges. The judge might, however, also serve as a coach if he/she is not judging for the same event. A federation that does not provide a judge will be fined 200 Euro, payable to the Organizing Committee.

Right after the conclusion of the event, the Host has to provide an electronic XML file to the WA (results@fina.org). This file should contain the detailed results including judge's scores for each dive.
