Practice Times

Practice times and the breaks between the competitions will be announced with the entry results.

General Rules and Notices

Competition Regulations

The competition regulations (WB), the legal system and the anti-doping regulations of the German Swimming Association (DSV) apply.

Eligibility

Eligible to participate are members of clubs that belong to a national swimming federation affiliated with World Aquatics and that own the federation's rights.

Competition Program

If there are fewer than 18 entries, the semi-finals will be held with 12 participants and the finals with 8 participants.

If the registered starts in the synchronized competitions (3-meter or platform) for men and women are less than 12 couples, the competitions will be combined.

Additional provisions:

() The 12 or 18 best in the respective preliminary competition qualify for the semi-finals. Foreign nations have the right to three starts in the semi-finals, provided their athletes have officially qualified in the preliminary competition. German athletes can be registered by the head national coach for the semi-finals outside of the competition, provided they are placed among the 12 or 18 best in the national ranking in the preliminary competition.*

*(**) The 8 or 12 best from the respective semi-finals qualify for the finals. Foreign nations have the right to two starts in the final, provided their athletes have officially qualified in the semi-finals. German athletes can be registered for the finals by the head national coach outside of the competition, provided they were placed among the 8 or 12 best in the national ranking in the semi-finals.*

In the Kürpokal, foreign athletes can take part in the competition for their respective nation. Each nation only has one right to start. Foreign clubs are not allowed to take part.

The preliminary competition for the Kürpokal will be held in a joint competition with the team championships. The Kürpokal and the team championships are counted separately.

Facility

The diving facility consists of a separate diving pool with five 1m and three 3m Maxi-B diving boards as well as a 1m, 3m, 5m, 7.5m and 10m platform, two 5m and 10m platforms, a hydraulic board as well as a hydraulic platform, a 60cm board and a pool edge platform. The water temperature is 30°C.

Entries

The entries for athletes take place according to the provisions of the WB, §210. The reports of the athletes and judges are to be entered via the online portal (www.sportlicht.net) on the Internet.

The Internet portal for registrations for this event closes automatically at the advertised registration deadline.

Registrations after the deadline must be done via email to ackmann@dsv.de and will incur an increased fee of €25 per start.

Diving Lists

The complete diving list must be entered Friday, 15.12.2023 (24 hours prior competition) (24 hours before the start of the event!) via the online portal (www.sportlicht.net).

Changes to dives are treated exclusively according to §210 paragraph 2 of the WB-FT-SPR!

Organisation Fee

An organization fee of €25 per registered participant (diver, coach & staff) will be charged.

Entry Fees

Individual event €20, Synchronized event €40

(Participation in the combination counts as a notifiable start!)

Organisation Fee

An organization fee of €25 per registered participant (diver, coach & staff) will be charged.

Judges

Each club that submits more than four entries must enter the name of at least one judge via the Internet portal and bear the costs for this judge. The judge must be in possession of a valid judge's license and be available on all competition days.

Each participating nation must appoint at least one judge in the technical meeting. If you are unable to appoint a judge, a fee of €300 will be due at the technical meeting.

Technical Meeting

Friday, 15.12.2023, 16:00 pm

The exact place and time will be communicated with the registration opening on an additional information sheet for the event.

All team leaders, judges and a technical employee are invited.

Awards

Cup for the first place, medals for places 1-3, certificates for the final places.

All award ceremonies of the day for the Kürpokal take place 15 minutes after the last final.

Accommodation

Catering

A snack bar is available in the diving hall from Thursday to Sunday.
